Space and equipment for sports

The University of Zagreb and the Faculty of Transport and Traffic Sciences encourage student sports, from competitive to recreational, as an integral part of academic life that improves the quality of studying and living. In addition to achieving academic excellence, the University encourages its students to actively engage in sports through the Sports Office, which has been modelled after similar offices at European universities. In addition to encouraging students to actively engage in sports and participate in university sports competitions, the Office's role is also manifested in spreading positive awareness and education about the importance of regular physical exercise, psychophysical development of young people, and about developing a competitive spirit, preserving health and fighting addiction. The Faculty of Transport and Traffic Sciences has a Committee for Sports that promotes recreational sports for students and coordinates and organizes training and selection of student representatives for UniSport ZG and UniSport HR competitions, European and world competitions, and the European Universities Games (EUG EUSA) and the World University Championships (FISU).
